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(d) The following references establish the execution of two alleged spies in CHA about 6 Jan '43.

(1) ATIS Document No. 1906, diary of YAMUKU, Fumitoshi (#1) of 144 Infantry Regiment, issued Oct '41 - 1 Jan '43, contains the following entries:

"10 Dec '41 - Landed (at CHA). The main base was offered by the enemy. Located the capital city, CHA by noon.

11 Dec - 200 prisoners of war.

4 Jan '43 - Suspended for the men who are said to be communicating with the American continent by wireless.

10 Jan - Saw two spies whom we caught yesterday, being shot.

(2) ATIS Document No. 1906, diary of YAMUKU, Fumitoshi (#1) of 144 Infantry Regiment, dated 22 Nov '41 - 1 Jan '43, contains the following entries:

"23 Dec '41 - Received leave for the first time in CHA Island.

10 Jan '43 - One was shot, 2 natives were executed by shooting. It was a native of CHA #13; one was a boy of 19 and the other a young man of 22. I believe that the natives who are shooting could not see very well. I saw 10 natives. The natives of CHA are called CHA #13; they are Asiatic.
