

In connection with the loss of the Montevideo Maru, we have already ordered our authorities concerned to report of its findings but as far as we hear at the Navy Department have been able to ascertain, the details regarding the incident are as follows:

The Montevideo Maru, belonging to the Osaka Shosen Kaisha and commandeered by the Imperial Japanese Navy, left Rabaul bound for Hainan Island on the 22nd of June, 1942 with about 1,000 prisoners of war on board. When she reached a point several miles off Bojeador Light House in the Philippines, before dawn on July 1, 1942, she was torpedoed by enemy submarine and was instantly sunk. Most of the men aboard got lost but the captain and more than ten of his men boarded a cutter and landed Bojeador. However, the captain and the majority of them were soon after murdered by bandits who infested the area and only five narrowly escaped, two of whom died subsequently. After wandering over ten days on foot the small party finally managed to reach Manila. It was on the report of these men that the authorities on the spot first learned of the incident and notified all officials concerned of the disaster. Moreover, an immediate search was ordered but due to the lapse of time, no trace of either ship or men could be found. It is possible that some of the prisoners of war may have been able to land somewhere but owing to the fact that the authority of our forces did not yet extend to that bandit ridden area, we were not able at the time to discover what had happened to the remaining men who were on board. We subsequently carried out mopping up operations by way of investigating what had happened to them, but without success.

Report re Japanese steamer "MONTEVIDEO MARU" torpedoed off
LUZON, 1 July 1942.

1. Preface. From information received it was known that about 1000 Australian PW and civilian internees taken by the Japanese in RABAU were shipped from there during June, 1942, to a destination unknown.

As Japan did not transmit the names or any information whatsoever concerning the above mentioned persons many enquiries were made by the Australian Authorities to Japan through the Protecting Power and IRCC, Geneva, but without effect.

This matter has accordingly been investigated, and the following report which is based on inquiries personally made at the Huryo ~~Joho~~ Kyoku (Prisoner of War Information Bureau) Foreign Office, the Navy and Army Ministries, Swiss Legation, International Red Cross, Japanese Red Cross Society and the Osaka Shosen Kaisha (owners of SS Montevideo Maru) is submitted for information, with the suggestion that it possibly offers an explanation as to why many Allied PW are still not accounted for.

2. Description of Casualty. (based on information provided by Navy Dept.) The SS "MONTEVIDEO MARU", owned by Osaka Shosen Kaisha and chartered by Japanese Navy left Rabaul on 22 June 1942, bound for HAINAN ISLAND carrying 845 PW, 208 civilian internees, the crew and a naval guard comprising an ensign, a medical orderly and 63 naval ratings.

Before dawn on 1 July 1942, whilst proceeding without escort, she was torpedoed at a point about 7 miles off BOJEADOR Lighthouse on north west corner of LUZON.

It is said that as the vessel sank instantly there was no time to launch any lifeboats or to radio a distress message. However the Captain and "more than 10" of the crew boarded a cutter that had floated off the sinking ship, and they eventually landed at BOJEADOR, where the majority of them, including the Captain, were killed by guerilla forces. Five of the party escaped and set out on foot for Manila, two died en route and the remaining three reached Manila after 10 days wandering. On arrival there they reported the sinking to the Japanese authorities, whereupon, according to the Navy Dept. "an immediate search was ordered, but due to the lapse of time no trace of either ship or men could be found. It is possible that some of the prisoners of war may have been able to land somewhere."

Information as to the casualties among the crew have not yet been confirmed, but this information is being sought from the owners of the vessel.

3. Notification of Casualty. On 20 July 1942 the Navy Dept. reported the sinking of "Montevideo Maru" to the owners.

On 6 January 1943 the Navy Dept. forwarded details of the sinking to the PW Information Bureau, together with a complete nominal roll of 848 PW and 208 civilians who were on board and presumed lost.

It is to be particularly noted that the later information was not communicated by the Information Bureau, and remained hidden in the files of the Bureau until discovered by the writer on 28 September 1945.

4. Enquiries made by IRC on behalf of Australia. Many written enquiries were made by the IRC Delegate in Tokyo to the Prisoners of War Information Bureau, culminating in a communication dated 20 April 1945, referring to a telegraphic advice from the Committee in Geneva that "information from Japanese Official sources of present welfare of enemy civilians and/or PW detained at Rabaul, New Britain is singularly lacking." and seeking information.

The Information Bureau took exception to the use of the phrase "singularly lacking" as conveying criticism, dissatisfaction, mistrust or suspicion and threatened a discontinuance of their information service including facilities for visits by IRC delegates to PW camps. Despite the Delegate's assurance that the phrase had been used by way of presenting a comparison, the Bureau demanded that the IRC Committee in Geneva should clarify their views in a manner satisfactory to Japan.

Despite the fact that the Bureau had withheld the information which it had received as far back as January, 1943, it has persistently informed all enquirers that all known information had been transmitted.

5. Enquiries made by Japanese Foreign Office. Owing to the destruction of the Foreign Office's records, full details of the enquiries made by the Foreign Office at the request of the Swiss Legation acting as Protecting Power for British interests are not available. However the Information Bureau has admitted that an official enquiry was received on 31 May 1944 from the Foreign Office concerning 199 named civilians taken by the Japanese in Rabaul. The Bureau did not transmit any reply to the Foreign Office, nor apparently did the Foreign Office press for a reply.

6. Enquiries made by Swiss Legation on behalf of Australian Authorities. More than 7 formal interventions were made by the Swiss Legation in an effort to secure information from the Foreign Office. In addition the Legation made numerous verbal enquiries and calls both on the Information Bureau and the Foreign Office. The Information Bureau gave no information and the Foreign Office generally ignored the enquiries. The only definite reply that was given to the Legation was to the effect that "it seems that none of the persons referred to are in the hands of Japan and it is believed that all may have taken refuge in the hills."


It will be noted that while the true facts were withheld, a story, which must have been known to have been false, was given out instead.

7. The Information Bureau's responsibility. Lt Gen TAMURA, Director of the Information Bureau, admits that the full details were in the possession of the Bureau since January 1943. He expresses regret that the information was not transmitted to Australia, but claims it was due to an oversight.

8. Letters addressed to the 1053 persons who were lost. The relatives of the PW and civilians who were lost have over a period of nearly 3-1/2 years,

been dispatching mail in the belief that their men folk were alive. Evidence is available from recovered PW who were working in the PW mail sorting centre at Omori Camp that a great deal of such mail reached Japan. In reply to my enquiries the Bureau has stated that all such mail has been forwarded from Japan to Rabaul. I have declined to accept that explanation and have made a demand for full details of the manner in which such mail was handled and disposed of and also its present whereabouts.

9. Investigations on other aspects of this case are continuing.

PW & CIVILIAN INTERNEES LOST on "MONTEVIDEO MARU" TORPEDOED OFF LUZON
on 1 JULY, 1942.

Nominal Rolls.

1. Forwarded herewith is the fourth installment of the nominal roll of personnel said to have been lost on "MONTEVIDEO MARU", comprising names of 86 PW. This roll covers a number of the serial numbers in the original roll which appear as blanks on the installments hitherto sent to you. They represent names that were previously difficult to identify.

2. The difficulty in identifying the names has arisen from various factors, viz:
- (a) Errors made by the Japanese translators when first rendering the names into Japanese katakana.
 - (b) Errors on the part of scribes when preparing the master copies from which the mimeographed copies of the roll were prepared.
 - (c) Poor reproduction of the mimeographed copy.
 - (d) Difficulty in determining which were the surnames and which the Christian names - the same order was not maintained throughout.
 - (e) Difficulty of identifying some of the translated names with any that appear in the Echelon rolls.

3. In view of the foregoing identification has been most difficult. In this connection the following explanatory comments on the attached roll are offered:

- (a) Some names are followed by a note of interrogation, e.g: Serial #101 WISE ?. This indicates a doubt as to whether the English rendering is correct.
- (b) Some names are rendered in rough phonetics, e.g: Serial #409 MURRAY ?, MARNEE-UST ?, GLEN ?. This is to indicate that the English rendering could not be guessed at with any degree of certainty.
- (c) Some names are followed by a name and then a note of interrogation, both of which are placed in brackets, e.g:
Serial #411 JAMES (JONES ?)
" #470 WAR (SHAW ?)

This is intended to indicate that the name in the brackets bears a resemblance to a greater or lesser extent to the translated name, or that an error appears to have crept into the Japanese rendering, but that in any event the name in the brackets is considered to be that intended.

It is thought that the details in the "place of birth" and "Age in 1942" columns will enable a check to be made by O2E on the identifications.

4. RECAPITULATION OF ROLLS THUS FAR DESPATCHED: In case of any of my despatches having been lost or delayed in transit, the following recapitulation of rolls

5. NAMES NOT YET IDENTIFIED. 47 names have not yet been identified on the roll of PW. Those names are marked with a red cross on the attached work sheets (Appendix A). It may not be possible for the writer to devote more time to the identification of the remaining 47 names, as these present particular difficulties.

Appendix A is therefore forwarded, and it is suggested that a translator of Japanese, working in conjunction with OZE staff will be able to identify those names.

Appendix A consists of an extract from the original roll, in which all columns other than the names have been translated. The names are in katakana as appearing on the original roll.

6. COMMENTS REGARDING THE ORIGINAL NOMINAL ROLL:

- (a) It consists of a mimeographed volume in Japanese of about 45 pages.
- (b) As already advised it was discovered in the files of the FWIB.
- (c) After the most extensive enquiries, it is now thought to be the only copy in Japan, and indeed the only copy in existence, unless other copies are found among documents captured in recovered territories.
- (d) As this copy has been, and still is, in frequent use, it has not been possible to forward the roll or to arrange for a photostatic copy to be prepared.
- (e) For the present the making of a photostat of a document of this nature cannot be done here. It would have to be sent to Manila for reproduction. In the circumstances no action is being taken for the present regarding the preparation of copies.

7. The preparation of the nominal rolls that have been forwarded has been conducted under rush conditions, and indulgence is requested in respect of any typographical errors.

NOMINAL ROLLS

1. Forwarded herewith is the third installment of the nominal roll of personnel said to have been lost on SS "Montevideo Maru". This represents a translation of a portion of the original roll in Japanese, which was forwarded by the Japanese Ministry of Navy to the Tokyo HURYO JOHO KYOKU (PWYB) on 6 Jan 1943 and comprises:
Civilian Internees - Serial Numbers 45 - 210.
2. Ross covering Serial Nos. 1 - 44 was forwarded on 6 Oct.
3. Reference to the roll will indicate that in translating the proper names from KATAKANA into English it has been necessary in many instances to produce a rough phonetical rendering e.g. Serial 62 - FARGARCUTSLAR. It is thought that the details against each name will enable identity to be established. It is likely that native place names have suffered considerable change in the process of being rendered into KATAKANA and back again into English.
4. It will be noted that many of the civilians appear to be of nationality other than British, although in some instances the details in the nationality column may have been intended as place of birth.
5. Six copies the complete roll of civilian internees (Serial Nos. 1 - 210) has been forwarded to the Recovered Personnel Division, AG-AFPAC, Manila, who, it is understood, will inform the countries concerned of the casualties of their nationals

A Report Indicating Japanese Vessels Sunk While Carrying
Allied Prisoners of War or Internees.

1. Monte-Video Maru: Port of embarkation -- Rabaul, was torpedoed on July 1, 1942 at true bearing 300° and distance 7 n.m. from Bogedor light-house, north-west of Luzon. ~~Most of the~~ 1054 passengers (845 Prisoners of War, 208 internees) are missing. The captain and more than 10 persons landed at Bogedor, were massacred by bandits except 5 (2 died later) who arrived at Manila by foot and reported the sinking of the ship.
2. Lisbon Maru: p. emb. - Hongkong, was torpedoed on October 2, 1942 at true bearing 352° and distance 5,6 n.m. from Tung-fu-Shan isl., China Sea coast. Out of 1816 passengers 977 rescued (12 dead in a Shanghai hospital), 839 missing (5 dead).
3. Nichimei Maru: p. emb. - Singapore, sunk by bombing January 15, 1943 at about $13^{\circ}34'N - 97^{\circ}27'E$. Out of 1000 passengers 947 rescued and 53 missing.

13. Tamaboko Maru: p.emb.-Batavia, after calling Singapore was torpedoed June 24, 1944 off Goto, near Nagasaki. Out of 772 passengers 212 rescued and 560 missing.
14. Harugiku Maru: p.emb.-Blawan, was torpedoed June 26, 1944 at $3^{\circ}15'N - 99^{\circ}47'$. Out of 720 passengers 543 rescued and 177 missing.
