cremated or buried within Japan during the war; Allied or U.S. Army personnel recovery parties have been unable to recover a large number of such remains. It is understood that in many cases information concerning the location of remains is not available in records of the Imperial Jpanese Government, but is known to police officials or local individuals.

2. The Imperial Japanese Government is directed to take such steps as is necessary to furnish this Headquarters complete information regarding the location of the remains of such deceased Allied Personnel throughout Japan. Reports will be submitted prior to 15 December 1945 and will include the following information:

- a. Name, rank, serial number of deceased
- b. Date, place and cause of death
- c. Exact present location of remains
- Names and addresses of persons cognizant of the location of such remains
- e. Any other pertinent data.
- 3. Receipt of this directive will be acknowledged.
