We know him from what his friends say about him to be a sort of man who would be able to devote himself to the cause of new and peaceful Japan, as he was so highly esteemed by his seniors and colleagues because of his excellent talent and ability. Though he himself was not a professed Christian the influence of early teaching of his Christian home continued in his later life. and he was reputed as a man of uprightness and astrong sense of responsibility, being respected and loved by his patients. We need such a physician to make a healthful nation and nothing is more regrettable than to lose him from Japan If his life could be spared and he could be given an opportunity

to make some atonement for whatever crimes he may have been responsible for through the remaining years of his natural life, his Christian wife and their children would be a support and encouragement through whatever sentence were given him.

- 1. The record of trial in the case of the above-named persons has been examined by GCM panel #TV and found to contain no error.

CHARGES: I-MURDER

- Spec.2 1 Feb 1944, IMANANI, same capacity and place, failed to control members of his command, in that he permitted named persons under his command to unlawfully kill two (2) American POWS by explosions of dynamite and by strangulation, this in violation of the laws and customs of war.



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- Spec 3 1 Feb 1944, IWANAMI, same capacity and place, failed to protect two (2) American POWS in that he permitted them to be killed by emplosions and strangulation by persons under his command and control, this in violation of the laws and customs of war.
- Spec 4 20 July 1944, IWANAMI, same capacity and place, failed to control members of his command, in that he permitted 17 named persons (all the other accused except SAKAGAMI) to unlawfully kill two (2) American POWS by bayeneting, by spearing, and by beheading with swords, this in violation of the laws and customs of war.
- Spec 5 20 July 1944, IWANAMI, same capacity and place, failed to protect two (2) American POWS, in that he permitted them to be killed by members of his command subject to his control, with spears and swords, this in violation of the laws and customs of war.
- Spec 6 3 Feb 1944, IWANAMI, same capacity and place, prevented the honorable burial of eight (8) American POWS who died in captivity of the Japanese armed forces, by dissection and mutilation of the bodies of the said prisoners, this in violation of the laws and customs of war.

PIEAS: Not guilty (all accused) to all charges and specifications.

FINDINGS: Guilty to all charges and specifications, except: Spec. 2 of Charge I, proved in part, (not proved as to IWANAMI, proved as to SAKAGAMI).

SENTENCES:

IWANAMI, /hanged by neck until dead, two-thirds of the members concurring. KAMIKAWA, to be confined for 20 years. 17 17 " 10 ASAMURA, SAKAGAMI, Ħ the term of his natural life. YOSHIZAWA, " Ħ 15 years. 10 HOMMA, -WATANABE, TANABE, MUKAI,

ACTION OF CONVENING AUTHORITI:

Approved the preceedings, findings of guilty, except on specificationsl, 4 and 5 of Charge II, and the sentences, and set aside the findings on specifications 1, 4 and 5 of Charge II.

ACTION OF REVIEWING AUTHORITY:

Approved the proceedings, findings of guilty, except on specifications 1, 1, and 5 of Charge II, and the action of the convening authority. In conformity with section D-ll, Naval Courts and Boards, transmitted the record to the Secretary of the Navy for confirmation of the death sentence as to the accused IMANAMI, Hiroshi, and to the Judge Advocate General of the Navy for revision and record.



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3. FACTS: Presecution - The acts alleged in the Charges and Specifications occurred during January, February and July of 1944 at Dublon Island, Truk. IWAMAMI was Commanding Officer of the Fourth Naval Hospital on Truk during the times of the alleged wrongful acts and KAMIKAWA, was his adjutant. OISHI was in charge of the Self Defense Unit and ASUMURA was in charge of the defense of the peninsula on which the hospital was located. SAKAGAMI, known as the Deck Officer, was serving as first lieutenant of the hospital. The rest of the accused performed various functions connected with the hospital.

In January of 1944 IWANAMI requested from the Commanding Officer of the Maval Guard Unit, located near the hospital, the use of eight (8) American prisoners of war for experiments. The eight POWS were taken to the sick bay of the NGU (1 of the 8 already a patient there). The sick bay of the NGU was a separate command from the hospital but IWANAMI acted in a supervisory capacity over it as senior medical officer on the area. On 30 January 1944 two dectors, now deceased, and IWANAMI performed shock experiments on four of the POWS by placing tourniquets on their arms and legs for long periods. The tourniquets were taken off of two POWS at the end of about two hours and off the other two at the end of seven hours, the latter two died immediately from shock, the former survived. The four other POWS were injected with streptococcus bacteria to cause septemia (blood poisoning). These four developed a high fever and soon died. Nakamura took notes during the experiments.

During the first of February 1944 the two surviving POWS were taken by one OKUGAMA, deceased, assisted by SAKAGAMI to a hill in back of the hospital and were tied to stakes with their legs wide apart. They were naked and were sitting on the ground. Dynamite (black blasting powder sticks) was put in shallow holes about three feet in front of each prisoner, the charges were then exploded and the feet of the Americans were torn but the prisoners remained conscious. Nakamura, the witness on the stand, testified that he was present, taking notes, and gave them morphine injections to relieve the pain, but the pain was so great that Okugama ordered SAKAGAMI to strangle the two prisoners. SAKAGAMI strangled them to death with his hands. Two native girls heard the explosions and soon after heard SAKAGAMI say that they had killed two Americans. The bodies were taken to the hespital where they were dissected, together with the bodies of the PCWS killed by shock, by IWANAMI and others. IWANAMI cut off their heads and had them boiled for specimens. The hearts and other organs were removed and put in specimen bottles. The bodies were not sewed up.

Note: The witness Nakumura after being cross-examined at length but before completion of cross-examination died. Accused moved to strike out all his testimony on the ground that accused had no opportunity to fully cross-examine him.

Overruled by court.

The bodies of the four POWS who died from septemia (blood poisoning) were also dissected and were shoved off a small clift by native workers under direction of SAKAGAMI. Loose dirt was shoveled on top of them and no markers were placed on the graves. There was testimony that the other four bodies were cremated.

During the last of July 1944 at an evening meal IMAMAMI asked all of the officers present if any one would like to perform experiments on two American POWS. No one desired to and IMAMAMI said that he would get the Self Defense Section to do it. Two days later on 20 July 1944, IMAMAMI had the two Americans taken to the hill behind the hospital to be executed. The arrangements were made by KAMIKAMA, the adjutant. The two Americans were tied upright to a bar suspended between two trees. General assembly was called and approximately 100 members of the hospital personnel gathered on the hill (all military except two natives who hid in palm trees). IMAMAMI made a speech denouncing the Americans for bombing of the hospital and ordered the line of stabbers to stab "with spirit". The stabbers had been lined up by OISHI and had been given spears and



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rifles with bayenets. The order was given through OISHI. OISHI ordered the mem to stab and they stabbed two at a time until the whole group had stabbed. There was some testimony that the order from IMANAMI was given through KAMIKAWA to OISHI. After the stabbers had finished IWANAMI ordered OISHI and ASAMURA to cut the necks of the two prisoners. Both cut the necks of the prisoners, however, ASAMURA did not hit a very good blow and he gave his sword to YOSHIZAWA who cut the neck of one of the prisoners. According to custom the heads were not completely severed. Three to six witnesses identified the following as being in the line of stabbers and all were seen, by some witnesses, stabbing the prisoners, to-wit: YOSHIZAWA, HOMMA, WATANABE, TANAME, MUKAI, KAWASHIMA, SAWADA, TANAKA, AKABORI, KAWABARA, TSUTSUI, NAMATAME, TAKAISHI and MITSUHASHI. The clething of the dead Americans were removed and the bodies were thrown in a grave dug near the scene of the execution.

Later IWANAMI during a staff meeting of the Fourth Fleet reported that experiments with steel spears on prisoners at the Fourth Naval Hospital showed that the spears were inferior because they bent. In September of 1945 IWANAMI requested permission to dig up the bodies of the two POWS who were executed in July. IWANAMI ordered HOMMA to dig up the bodies and dispose of them in the sea. This was done.

Defense: - SAKAGAMI denied that he took part in the dynamiting and strangulation of the two POWS, but admitted that he furnished dynamite (to blow up dogs) and was present while the drugs were injected into the two POWS. Claims that Hekamura made false statements.

There was testimony that KAMIKAWA made the statement that he would have nothing to do with the plans for the July execution. Other witnesses testified that they did not see KAMIKAWA on the hill during the July execution. KAMIKAWA denied that he went to the hill or that he had anything to do with the executions.

The efficer-in-charge of a group which included SAWADA and WATANABE, testified that these two men were not in the group of stabbers. WATANABE admitted that he had a bayonet but denied that he stabbed. SAWADA admitted that he dug the grave for the POWS but denied that he stabbed.

IWANAMI testified that he did not arrange or give permission for the holding of the January experiments but admitted that he was there and made blood tests on the Americans. He did not know of the experiments with dynamite and the stangulations but admitted that he dissected the bodies of the Americans. Demied that he permanently removed the organs of the POWS but admitted that he cut off four heads had them boiled and sent to Tokyo. Testified that he didn't know anything about the January experiments until they were over and then did not report the doctors involved because it would get himself in trouble.

IMANAMI admitted the entire July executions, his sole defense being that since it had been 10 days since the Americans had bombed the hospital he thought all trial proceedings had been completed. His justification being that the Americans bombed the hospital marked with the international Red Cross symbol. His motive was revenge. Testified that he ordered all involved to do what they did and that since he as Commanding Officer of the Hospital had ordered it, they could not refuse. Demies the truth of his former statement in which he said that KAMIKAWA, his adjutant, made the preparations for the executions.

OISHI admitted his part in the July executions but contended that he was acting under orders. He testified that MUKAI did not stab. KANIKAWA told OISHI to dispose of the Americans since he was head of the Self Defense Section and OISHI expressed his disapproval.

ASHAMURA admitted that while under orders he tried to cut the neck of one of the POWS but did not do so well and gave his sword to YOSHISAWA who cut the POW.



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YOSHIZAWA admitted that he cut the prisoners neck during the July executions stating that he had much training in such procedure and could have easily severed the head from the body if he had desired, however, it was the custom to leave about an inch hanging. Testified that TANABE was sick during July of 19hh.

HOMMA admitted his part in the stabbing but did not think he had done wrong. Testified that he was the first to stab and he aimed at the prisoners heart and stabbed. He testified that he would have been put to death if he had not obeyed the orders to stab.

TANABE denied participating in the July executions, his defense was that he had dengue fever and was in the hospital. KAMIKAWA testified that TANABE was sick during the middle of July. TANABE explained that the six witnesses who saw him in the line of stabbers were mistaken and had testified falsely.

NAMATAME denied being one of the stabbors in the July executions but remembered that he buried the bodies after the stabbing. He did not see TAKAISHI during the stabbing although he was watching.

MUKAI testified that he was on the hill during the July executions and even though he was the third ranking petty officer, he didn't line up as a stabber when ordered to do so. The witnesses who saw him stab gave false testimony.

KAWARARA denied being a stabber but admitted that before the executions he went after the two American POWS and took them to the hill to the scene of the executions.

4. APPLICABLE IAW AND DISCUSSION

The accused made a plea to the jurisdiction of the commission to try the accused for offenses occurring in 1944 on Truk which at that time was under the sovereignty of Japan. The plea was overruled. It was held in the Supreme Court case of In Re Yamashita, 327 U.S. 1, that, "Japan by her acceptance of the Potsdam Declaration and her surrender, has acquiesced in the trials of those guilty of violations of the law of war." Charges I and II and the specifications thereunder all allege crimes which are violations of the law and customs of war. The jurisdiction of the commission, which was convened by competent authority, was complete to try the accused.

The convening authority in his action on the record set aside all the specifications of Charge II (specs. 1, 4 and 5) which he had preferred for the contingencies of proof. Specification 2 and 3, which both allege that IWANAMI permitted members of his command to kill the same two POWS, are not duplicitious. Specification 2 alleges that IWANAMI failed to control members of his command, as was his duty, in that he permitted them to kill two POWS. The Supreme Court in the Yamashita case, supra, recognised this as an offense in violation of the law and customs of war. Specification 3 alleges that IWANAMI failed in his duty to protect prisoners of war, in that he permitted the two POWS to be killed. The Supreme Court in the Yamashita case, supra, has this to say, "These provisions Articles 1, 19 and 13 of the Fourth Hague Convention of 1907 and Article 26 of the Geneva Red Cross Convention of 1929 plainly imposed on petitioner * * * an affirmative duty to take such measures as were within his power and appropriate in the circumstances to protect prisoners of war * * *." The gist of specification 2 is the neglect of the accused in his duty to control members of his command in order to prevent them from violating the law and customs of war. The gist of the offense alleged in specification 3 is the failure of the accused in his duty to protect prisoners of war within his command. The offenses allege separate failures and neglects and are separate and distinct even though the result (the killing of the same POWs) is the same.



During the course of the trial a witness for the prosecution, MAKAMURA, Shigeyoshi, died before completion of his cross-examination by the defense. (Page 92 of the record) His death (suicide) was apparently due to no fault of either the prosecution or defense. He was on the stand for part of the fourth day of trial and all of the fifth and sixth days of trial were devoted solely to the cross-examination of this witness by the counsel for the accused. The accused moved for a mistrial and later for this witness' testimony to be stricken from the record, contending that the accused's right of full cross-examination was prohibited. The court overruled both motions.

It is believed that the correct rule is stated by Prof. Wigmore in section 1390, Vol. V of Wigmore on Evidence, 3rd Edition, as follows:

"But, where the death or illness prevents cross-examination under such circumstances that no responsibility of any sort can be attributed to either the witness or his party, it seems harsh measure to strike out all that has been obtained on the direct examination. Principle requires in strickness nothing less. But the true solution would be to avoid any inflexible rule, and to leave it to the trial judge to admit the direct examination so far as the loss of cross-examination can be shown to him to be not in that instance a material loss."

It is true as contended by the accused that cross-examination is a matter of right, but its proper bounds are within the sound discretion of the trial judge. U.S. v. German-American Vocation League, 153 F. 2d 860, certiorari denied 66 S.Ct. 979, but the discretion can be exercised only after a party has had an opportunity substantially to exercise the right of cross-examination. Lindsey v. U.S., 133 F. 2d 36B. Where no objection was made to an adjournment before cross-examination was completed and the witness died during the adjournment only that part of the witnesses testimony which had not been cross-examined should be stricken from the record. Curtis v. West, 2 N.Y.S. 507.

An examination of the testimony of the witness, MAKAMURA, shows that counsel for the accused cross-examined him extensively and covered fully every thing which the witness testified to on direct examination. It is noted t in this connection that the judge advocate objected on many occasions that the cross-examination was repetitious.

In view of the above it is considered that the court properly overruled the motions of the accused.

Further, without going into the competency or incompetency of NAKAMURA's testimony, it is considered that the relaxed SCAP rules of evidence, which permit unsworn statements, hearsay and otherwise incompetent evidence to be introduced for the probative value they may contain, would have permitted retention of NAKAMURA's testimony even if he had not been cross-examined at all.

5. CONCLUSIONS AND RECOMMENDATIONS: It is recommended that the case be passed as legal and that a straight legal referral sheet be prepared.
