GLOSSARY OF TERMS USED IN THE TEXT

AHLLADIJAH. Religious Islam movement, founded at Djokjakarta in 1930. Teachings differ greatly from orthodox Islam.

AMAT SERINGKEI (The Big Four). Central propaganda and planning organization of leading Indonesian collaborators.

AUXILIARY AID SOCIETIES. Red Cross-like organizations, bringing relief and assistance to dependents of Indonesian soldiers and labor troops.

BARISAN HIZBOELLAH (Army of Allah). Moslem association, offering special training in Islamic collaborationism.

BARISAN PELOPOR (Shock Brigade; Pioneer Group). Adjunct of Public Service Association; composed of extremist elements checking on public and party officials; at first purely non-military, its program now includes military training.

CO-OPERATIVE SOCIETIES. Jap-sponsored trading concerns, operated locally by Indonesian collaborationist profiteers on a monopoly basis; co-operatives have power to fix prices of commodities.

CENTRAL ADVISORY COUNCIL (Dewan Sanyo). Advises the Central Government. Consists of Departmental and Provincial advisors. Established in Nov 44.

CENTRAL COUNCIL. Nominally the continuation (for Java) of the VOLKSRAAD (People's Council), the pre-war central legislative body of the Indies.

HEI HO. Jap-organized labor units, composed of Indonesians; used as labor troops at Jap fighting fronts.

HOME GUARD (Auxiliary Defense Corps; Peta; Java Defense Corps). National Guard-like organization; completely military in character, but on a part-time training and service basis, also engages in auxiliary police duty.

INDIA INDEPENDENCE LEAGUE. Organization of natives from British India residing in Java; supports Japanese in program to separate India from Britain.

KAIBODAN (Civil Defense Corps; Home Defense Assistance Association). Air-raid protection service; also engages in auxiliary police duty.

LANDRAAD. Lower court of justice.

MADJELIS ISLAM (Islamic Council). Religious Federation promoting Islam support of Japan's war effort; its functions were taken over by MASJOEMI late '43.

MASJOEMI (Moslem Supreme Council). Japanese-sponsored liaison Federation of Moslem Associations NAHDLAOEL OELAMA, MOHLIMADIJAH, PERSATOEAN OEMAT and PERIKATAN OEMAT ISLAM; established late in '43, Masjoemi directs Jap-inspired religious propaganda.

MOHLIMADIJAH. Established at Djokjakarta in 1912, as a non-political Islam organization. Program includes religious reforms and social-educational activities.

MANDATOEL OELMA (Rising of the Religious Teachers). Islam organization established at Soerabaja in 1926. Stands for orthodox Islam teachings.

PATIH. Assistant to Regent; deputy Regent.

PERKOEMPOELAN KAOENI CELEBES. Union of Natives from Celebes residing in Java.

POETERA. First Indonesian Collaborationist Party; in 1943 amalgamated into Public Service Association (Hokokai).

PUBLIC SERVICE ASSOCIATION (Hokokai; Himpoenan Kebaktian Rakjat). Most important collaborationist political organization; controls local politics and all Japanese-inspired organizations in Java, such as racial, professional and religious groups, Kaiboden, Honeguard, Heiho and Soekarela.

ROMUSHIA. Volunteer labor organization; strives to recruit white-collar workers for casual work projects.

VOLKSRAAD (Peoples Council). Pre-war legislative body of the Indies.

WEDANA. District Chief; under the Regent.

WOMEN'S ASSOCIATION (Fujinkai). Women's adjunct of Public Service Association; intends to improve welfare, lend first aid, take care of children etc.

YOUTH CORPS (Penoeda; Seinendan). Sponsored by Japanese to control younger generation and educate future collaborators; association carries on auxiliary police, A.R.P., labor duties, and includes military training.

His system grew rapidly and before the war there were more than 250 schools of the Taman Siswa type all over the Indies. In 1928 he adopted the new name of Ki Hadjar Dewantara, which literally means "Teacher who preaches all the Gods," a name symbolizing his educational philosophy.
