



SUBJECT: Colonel Cornelius Z. Byrd, ASN 0-17760.

Summary_of_Information:

Informant believes that Colonel Byrd was in Mindanao when the Philippine Islands fell and that he was taken prisoner by the Japanese at that time. He was originally imprisoned at Malay Balay and from there he was sent to Davao. Informant first saw Colonel Byrd when they were both confined by the Japanese at Davas Prison Camp, in October 1942. Informant was transferred to the Japanese Prison Camp at Cabanatuan in July 1944, where he again saw Subject, a fellow prisoner. At this time Colonel Byrd was in good health. Byrd had been sent to Cabanatuan from Manila.


Colonel Byrd was sent to Bilibid in October 1944 to be shipped to Japan. with other American officers, when an American invasion of the Philippines was imminent. He was on the transport which left the Philippines on 12 December 1944. This transport is believed to have been sunk by an American submarine on 13 December 1944. The Japanese gave the American prisoners of war in the Philippines a list of American officers allegedly lost in these sinkings. Colonel Byrd's name did not appear thereon.

The above information has been reported by two reliable informants, American officers who were liberated from Japanese prison camps.

I. General Account.

Statement of Mr. Robert S. Overbeck, covering 11 October to 27 October 1944:

On October 11, 1944, we left BILIBID Prison, MANILA and marched down to Pier #7 where we were put on board a 5,000 ton Japanese freighter, quite newly constructed (looked like a wartime construction job). The freighter was completely empty except for some coal in the #1 hold and some supplies. (Noticed dates of 1941 on the steam winches of the ship). The ship had four holds----the engine room was aft of the #4 hold. There were 1800 Americans and we were all put into #2 hold which was divided into three tiers with about three feet of space between tiers. We were very cramped as there was no room to stand up

or move. Estimated to be about three hundred to three hundred fifty Japanese - civilians, crew and guards - aboard.

As we boarded the ship the alert sirens in MANILA sounded and we pulled out just after dark. We noticed a number of ships sunk in the harbor. We headed due west and then southwest. We traveled for two days in convoy, with escort. The convoy consisted of four or five trawlers, two destroyers, one heavy cruiser, (assumed to be a heavy cruiser although it had no more than six guns), thirteen freighters and one passenger liner. After about two days, on the afternoon of the second day, at about two thirty p.m., we pulled into a small cove in a small island. I think that the island was a part of the CUYO Islands or the CULION Islands, an estimated two to three hundred miles from MANILA. There was a small airfield close by, behind a ridge of small hills. Two aircraft with fixed landing gears, would fly around and land behind the ridge. We arrived there on the 13th and spent six days there; then went up the VERDE Island passage and arrived back in MANILA about noon on the 20th. Three or four more ships were sunk within the breakwater. The ship pulled out in the dark in the morning of the 21st. We proceeded in a general northward direction until five p.m. on the 24th when we were torpedoed by an American submarine. Three torpedoes were fired, the first two missing the ship and the third catching us in the #3 hold. At the time of the attack they were holding a NNE course. The first torpedo was fired at 1655, Philippine

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time, and the second only some thirty seconds to a minute later. The torpedo that hit the ship was fired at 1710. The torpedo hit the #3 hold on the starboard side. Position of the ship was roughly, close to the PRATAS Reefs.

There was no way of knowing how many ships were in the convoy at the time of the attack as they were very widely dispersed. We understood that another ship in the convoy was sunk previously because at four p.m., before the torpedoing, we had an alert and during that alert we saw a lifeboat and bits of wreckage right off our starboard so we figured another ship had been torpedoed. The ship mounted four heavy machine guns - their A/A guns, and one dual-purpose 105mm (?) gun, aft.

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and

When the torpedo struck, the ship buckled in the middle and the forward part of the ship stayed level but the stern went down. The Nips abandoned ship at once, first driving all Americans into the holds. Six hundred Americans were in the #1 hold and the Nips cut the ropes (rope ladder) leading into this hold before abandoning ship. We had wooden stairs in #2 hold. After the Nips abandoned ship, Americans coming on deck from #2 hold, dropped a rope to the men in #1 hold. They tied on the rope ladder and it was pulled up and fastened. Two destroyers showed up almost immediately and they pulled up (not too close) to the ship and picked up the Nips at once. Americans were not picked up by the <u>destroyers - the Japs did not shoot at the Americans in the water</u>

but they threw objects at us and used clubs to beat on the men when they came near the destroyer. We think the destroyer threw off a depth charge but are not sure.

The freighter was not loaded at all and apparently they were going to pick up a cargo at TAIWAN. The Nips were constantly changing the number on the ship and we think it was #8 when it was torpedoed. The number was on the smokestack and might have indicated the position of the ship in convoy and been changed as the ship's position changed.

I got into a lifeboat about dark. The freighter had not yet sunk although the boilers had blown up. During the night, two



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of the other boys swam up to the boat. All night we heard many men calling to one another, trying to get together in groups. At daybreak, the other two fellows came up on a raft. (There were many sick and wounded on board the freighter and the water was so cold and many men in such poor condition that approximately 75% couldn't withstand it and dropped from wreckage, etc., to which they were clinging). A box floated by, which I caught and found it contained a sail and a sea anchor. We bailed the boat out and mounted the mast ... There was no one in sight. Then' a destroyer showed up - circled us a few times and passed within a hundred yards of us. We laid down in the boat and they didn't make any attempt to pick us up, after looking us over. As soon as the destroyer left we again put up the sail and took off, heading NW. We made good time with a high wind----probably six knots. We sailed all the day of the 25th and all night and all of the 26th, until dark. We spotted many junks toward evening and finally pulled up along side one. They threw a rope to us and we got on deck. The men on the Chinese junk couldn't speak English but when we mentioned Chiang Kai Chek, everything was okay. The Chinese tore the lifeboat apart, threw everything that was Japanese, overboard and sank the lifeboat. The next day, October 27th, they brought us in to port - about noon. We landed at a place called KITCHIOH at about 115-50E, 22-48N. heand During our trip we sighted some Japanese planes, about noon of the 26th, $also_{A}a$ bomber at noon of the 25th.



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II. Trip From China Coast to KUNMING. Statement of 1st Sgt. Calvin R. Graef, covering 26 October to 12 November 1944.

Toward evening of the 26th of October we pulled along side the largest of a number of Chinese junks and the crew immediately threw us a rope and pulled the lifeboat close to the junk. This junk was 75 to 80' long. They took us aboard one at a time and then gathered around us. We tried to explain to them, as soon as we found out that they were Chinese, that we had come off of a ship that had been torpedoed and that we wanted to try to get through to Free Chinese Forces. They could not understand us until we mentioned Chang Kai Chek and then they seemed to understand. The captain of the junk brought out paper and pencil and wrote "We go China today" but we didn't know whether he meant "today" or "two day". He explained that they were not Japanese. The women on the junk prepared food - rice, fish, etc., and we sat down to eat. We had lived on Japanese hardtack while in the lifeboat, rationed at the rate of fifteen cookies, three times per day. We had very little water in the lifeboat - about three PER MAN ounces, were used during the entire trip. The women on the junk also brought us water and after we finished eating, they brought out tobacco. The Chinese then began pulling in their fish nets. Whenever they could, the Chinese helped us stand up, sit down,

walk, etc., and generally treated us like China dolls - really treated us marvelously.

About two hours later, after the crew had finished pulling in their nets, we had some more food.

After eating, we went down to the crew's quarters and they fixed us up with water and towels and we took a bath (our first fresh water bath in a very long time). They wouldn't give us our old clothes back and gave us clean, Chinese clothing - very warm. They fixed us up a place to sleep, topside, gave us blankets, etc. We were very warm and comfortable. The water was quite rough and when it started to rain we moved down to the crew's quarters.

In the morning of the 27th of October we sighted the China Coast. We pulled into a group of junks not very far off of the mouth of the river leading to KITCHIOH (22-48N, 115-50E). As soon as we joined the junk fleet we were surrounded by all of the junks and everybody brought presents, food, etc.

The Chinese junk captain told us to go with him and he took us ashore in a sampan. It took us two hours to get in to KITCHIOH. From there we went to a dentist's office where we waited for one of the town officials who spoke English. When he arrived, we explained the situation to him and he took us to one of the town buildings where we could have a little privacy. (The whole town had been watching us, crowding around, etc.) The rest of that day we did nothing but eat. We were told immediately upon landing that there was an American official who would be in the next day. The town official got a detailed report from us which he sent to his commander who in turn sent it to the Fourteenth Air Force. Two hours after we landed, the Fourteenth Air Force Headquarters at HINGNING (24-05N, 115-45E) had been notified.

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We stayed there that night, at a school, and all the next day, the 28th of October, and the next afternoon a representative of the Fourteenth Air Force, a Chinese civilian, came to us and said that he would take us to General Yu's headquarters at KITCHIOH (temporary headquarters). (General Yu is General Stilwell's former aide in Burma). Here we met Cpl. Baron of A.G.F.R.T.S.

After we saw the General (he wanted to hear our story - especially our treatment by the Chinese), he told us that it would be

better for us to leave the next morning and told us we had to walk since he had been unable to get any bicycles, sedan chairs, etc. There are no roads out of KITCHIOH, only foot paths. The • next day, 29 October, we walked to a town 20 miles from there -LUKFUNG. There we had a banquet and the next morning, 30 October, at eleven a.m., we left for Cpl. Baron's headquarters at HOIFUNG. Baron's party had to make a trip through the country and they wouldn't be able to see us again for four days. The general sent a guard and an interpreter with us. We remained at HOIFUNG for four or five days and then left for HINGWING, by bicycle. The trip took us about two and one half days. We arrived in HINGNING on 7 November, election day. The Chinese interpreter and one Chinese officer took this trip with us. We remained at HINGNING the rest of the day and left the next morning for NAMYUNG, by weapons-carrier, and arrived in NAMYUNG the evening of the second day, be November. We remained there that night and the next days and left NAMYUNG for KUNMING by plane at noon on 12 November. We stopped for a few minutes at NAMNING for gasoline and arrived at KUNMING at eight o'clock the night of the same day.

The interpreter told us that the Chinese junk captain had been picked up by the Japs and then released. He had been picked up on an island about three miles from where we landed, where the Japs have a small garrison. The Japs picked the junk captain up the day after we landed. The Chinese told us that the Japs stopped quite a few of the junks; we don't know whether the Japs knew

anything or whether it was a routine examination. Some said the Nips let him go because they feared reprisals from his pirate friends and relatives.

Our treatment by the Chinese has been really perfect. The Chinese were reimbursed by Captain Lynn (Cpl. Baron wired Captain Lynn for funds). We also understand that the Chinese junk captain was rewarded by the Fourteenth Air Force and also is to receive a medal from the Fourteenth. The number fourteen is extremely well-known, well-liked and

important to all Chinese.

The persons named are recognized as having been on the ship sunk December 15 and are presumably the 59 referred to in prior report as having died subsequently.



9. a. On 8 September 1945 U.S. 3256 received reporting 65 POWs as died Fukuoka camp January and February 1945. All were on 15 December ship, rescued, reshipped on 27 December and died later. None appear on the prior lists of transfers.

b. On 19 September 1945 U.S. 3266 received reporting 32 POWs as died during transport to Japan from Philippines. These are identified as having been on 15 December ship, rescued, reshipped on 27 December and died later. None have been previously reported as transferred or otherwise.

10. The data in preceding paragraph brings the summary to the following:



Allowing for a few discrepancies and duplications it is believed the foregoing fully accounts for the 1555 Americans. It is of course possible that some of the above 431 will be found to have died.

Lieutenant Colonel Peck, a repatriate estimates that of the 1619 aboard, there were 1278 deaths and 341 survivors.






