EXCELLENCY:

Re: Nagoya Prisoner of War Camp  
Kamioka Sub Camp

On behalf of the Prisoners of War occupying the above camp represented as follows: 2 Officers and 326 N.C.O.'s and Privates of the United States Forces, 1 Officer and 4 Privates of the British Forces and 17 Officers and 215 N.C.O.'s and Privates of the Royal Netherlands E. Indian Army we address a request for your Excellency's earnest consideration as protector of American and British Interests in Japan. For Your Excellency's Guidance we might add that the Dutch and British Arrived here in December 1942 whereas the American 1st and 2nd Detachments came to this camp in May and August 1944

Due to the nature and duration of our imprisonment and prevailing general conditions the standard of health in this camp has reached a serious if not alarming stage. Many men vis: 15 Americans, 2 British and 63 Dutch has succumbed to the hardships of Prisoner of War Life.

All attempts of the Japanese Authorities to mitigate existing conditions have failed. Proof of this can be found in the fact that out of the above total of dead 11 Americans and 19 Dutchmen died since January 1st of this year. Consequently we may expect to be faced with an even graver situation in the near future.

We therefore beg of your Excellency to acquaint the International Red Cross Society with the state of affairs in this camp and to also notify His Excellency the Swedish Minister at Tokyo who is looking after the interests of the Netherlands Subjects in this country.

We would be grateful to Your Excellency to enclose two copies of "Personal Affairs of Military Personnel and Aid for their Dependents"-- U.S. War Department Pamphlet -- when acknowledging receipt of this letter.

TO : Colonel Marcus, Director Recovered Personnel, AFWESPAC,  
APO 707.

1. Reference is made to my Memorandum 24 January 1946 to the Director Recovered Personnel Division, AFWESPAC, attention being invited to the fifth paragraph of that Memorandum.

2. A few of the reports mentioned in that paragraph are attached. These reports are compiled from radios sent by the Japanese Government to Geneva for transmission to the Government concerned. We find in many instances that the names and the diagnosis given are not correct. Therefore Geneva is not receiving correct information. ATIS personnel on duty with this office are checking each one carefully and correcting all mistakes so you can be assured of true information.

3. In the future we will use a mimeograph for<sup>m</sup> entitled "Unreported Deaths of Allied Personnel". These will be submitted daily regardless of how few we have finished.

4. Also enclosed are twenty-five (25) copies of the Shanghai Death List.
