HISTORICAL SUMMARY OF PRISONER OF WAR CAMPS IN JAVA, NEI, 1942

- l. I and my air crew were taken Prisoners of War by the Japanese near the town of Kendal, on the north coast of Java, about 15 miles west of SEMARANG. We were taken the afternoon of March 9 and kept under the guard of native collaborators that night. The following morning we were sent to the Japanese barracks in Semarang where we were questioned by the C. O. The questioning was mild and surprisingly unimportant, consisting primarily of personal matters name, age, children, etc. The Japanese Commanding Officer threatened physical compulsion when I declined to answer a question regarding recent bombing activity, but was dissuaded by the Dutch officer who was acting as limison for us.
- 2. We were then given a choice of internment. The Japanese force consisted of only a platoon and was unable to spare any men for a prison guard. We could either go to the native prison or be turned over to the Dutch STMADTWACHT (Home Guard) for custody. We chose the latter, and the Dutch commander was informed that if we escaped he and his detachment would be killed. The Dutch commander did not wish to lose his head nor to incarcerate us. He asked us for our parole to remain in the vicinity of the building serving as quarters and office; we discussed the matter and deciding it was the most advisable procedure, gave him our parole as requested.
- With the quick retreat and surrender of the Dutch, the natives proclaimed their inalienable rights to freedom as expounded by the Japanese propaganda of Greater East Asia Co-Prosperity Sphere and self-government for the subject populations that had been under colonial rule. Many houses, bodegas, and industries belonging to Occidentals and Chinese merchants (also a creditor class) were burned down and there were mild disorders of rioting and locting. The Japanese kept the local Dutch Home Guard under arms and together they restored the natives to their former status of a subject people. About March 20, a large force of the Japanese Army arrived as reinforcements; they took over the local government and police functions and the Dutch were then relieved of their arms and put in jail. The 6 Americans and 2 Australians were sent to another camp at Magelang in central Java.
- 4. The food was plentiful and was well prepared by the wives of the Dutch officers. It was our first contact, 3 times a day, with Dutch and Javanese cooking, and while in retrospect it was magnificent, at the time, the cold breakfast, the eternal rice and very hot seasoning were not very appetizing.

MAGELANG

The Prisoner of War camp at Magelang was located in a former RNEI Army garrison. Officers were quartered in the non-commissioned officers' quarters, two or three to a formerly one-man apartment. Enlisted personnel were quartered in the barracks. Of the total of about 2,000 in the camp, there were 6 Americans, 3 English and 6 Australians. The remainder were mostly Javanese who had thrown away their uniforms after the Japanese invasion and were now wearing the native dress. They had turned themselves in as POWs in order to obtain free food and lodging and to avail themselves of any opportunities to serve to the announced new army of pseudo-free Java.

Conditions in this camp were definitely the best of any camp that I was in. There were no work parties and the Japanese left us alone. The food was plentiful and healthful, being practically the same as that of the peace-time RNEI army. We were quite exhausted after the previous hectic months and the month of rest and good food that we received in this camp went a long way to restoring us to a fair condition of health. We had a limited library and facilities for recreation and athletics, but they were sufficient to fill in the time we were at this camp. Every afternoon, the families and friends of the Dutch and natives were permitted to visit them and to bring them food, to-bacco, books or practically anything that they might request. The two Japanese officers in the camp both spoke English to a limited extent and were always courteous towards us. As a general rule, the Japanese officers and non-commissioned officers of the combat units were more decent to FOWs than were those who never left the homeland, or were sent out as garrison troops rather than as combat troops.

The latter part of April, 1942, the POWs of white or part white ancestry were sent to Soerabsja; the full-blooded natives were then released for the most part.

SOERABAJA

The first camp at Soerabaja was in the Jaarmarkt (Fair Grounds). The place was crowded when we arrived, with an estimated 4,000 Dutch. There were about 25 Americans from the 2nd Battalion, 131st F. A., 36th Division, captures at Soerabaja, and about 100 British, mostly from the destroyers Jupiter and Electra and a few RAF. The buildings were all filled and we had to sleep on the open ground. The internal administration was in the hands of the Dutch and was very inefficient and corrupt. The staff received quantities of food for themselves; and the special food for the hospital went to the medical staff instead of the patients.

The food itself was not too bad. It was, however, not fairly distributed and was prepared with indifference and incompetence. All men of all ranks connected with the kitchens were extraordinarily fat. On several occasions, the native troops rioted in the mess line because of discrimination.

Work parties were small and not very severe. Those who went on them were able to make purchases from native vendors, thus making the assignment highly desirable.

There were few books or opportunities for athletics, recreation or amusement. Washing facilities were very inadequate and camp was generally filthy. There was likewise considerable friction between nationalities and between cliques of the services of the nationalities. Morale was bad and there was but little spirit of mutual cooperation or a united front against the Japanese.

The Japanese changed guard on the hour, marching through the camp in doing so. POWs were required to bow down, head as low as the waist, as soon as the guard approached within 25 yards and to hold the bow until they had passed a like distance beyond. Every man was ordered to shout "Kirai" (Attention) as loud as he could when he saw the guard. Any one who did not comply or did not obviously display proper subservience was ismediately explained his short-comings with rifle butt and shoe.

The first part of May, several hundred FOWs were sent to a nearby school building, H. B. S.; this group included the British Navy Group, R.A.F., and my air crew.

About the latter part of July or first part of August, the Dutch were all concentrated in the camp at Jaarmarkt and all British (including Australians and Caradians) totaling about 2,100; Americans, about 120; Chinese, about 100; natives, from Ambon and Menado, about 100; and a few civilians of miscellaneous nationality, were incarcerated in H. B. S.

Housing facilities were better in H. B. S. than at Jaarmarkt. The building was concrete, and though the tile floors without mattresses or blankets made a hard bed, we could at least keep the rooms clean. Bathing facilities were poor consisting of merely a few drinking fountains from which we could splash water for a bath. Latrine facilities were fair, although we could not use toilet paper, firstly because there was none, secondly, because it was forbidden to use it if one had any.

The food situation steadily deteriorated. Occasional issues of fruit, meat, and sugar gradually shrunk until practically non-existent. The breakfast was a thin rice porridge; lunch, one small roll; and supper, an insufficient amount of boiled rice and a watery soup with several pieces of cucumber and numerous grubs and worms. We lost considerable weight; the small bulk of the food is demonstrated by the fact that the majority of men had a bowel movement about once every 7 to 10 days.

The diet, hygiene, tropical heat, and lack of medicine soon brought on an outbreak of skin diseases. The sick call was very large, although deaths were few. Serious cases were sent to the local hospital, still operated by the Dutch. The camp hospital was far more efficiently and honestly run, although receiving less supplies and special foods, than the one at Jaarmarkt.

When the Dutch left, an RAF officer took over the camp; his administration was mediocre - devoid of initiative, force, and energy. He was somewhat of an Americanphobe and discriminated in some small ways against the Americans.

While at this camp, the Japanese conducted a fairly thorough survey of pilots. The physical test included obtaining the Schneider index of each pilot, his measurements, and reflexes. The technical questions were naive and nothing of any importance was asked; the average reader of pre-war American daily papers and magazines would have known the answers. As an example, from the secret files of the Intelligence Officer's carefully guarded portfolio, a page from a magazine that I surmised to be TIME was displayed for us. The written matter on it was carefully covered up and we were told to identify the picture. It was a cigarette ad, Camels, if I recall correctly, showing a test pilot riding a stationary exercise bicycle with an oxygen apparatus. The story I believe, was that he would "supercharge" his bloodstream with oxygen before test-flying the revolutionary P-38 (circa 1939?). He was also proving, for an additional recompense, that Camels(?) did not shorten his wind, or impair his flying. The story seemed to fascinate the Japs and they slyly asked us what the contraption was. One pilot replied that it was a portable electric generator set that all ground crows manned to light an airfield at night. Another replied that it was the way the pilots got their exercise so they wouldn't have to leave the field. I informed him all U. S. A. Air Corps pilots used them before every flight. All this was made a matter of record, and evidently satisfied the interrogator.

Other tests evidently measured mental, manual, and optical dexterity. They included rapid manipulation of a telegraph key, putting together a jigsaw puzzle, solving of little tricks and puzzles used to amuse adolescents, rapidity in counting or segretating various forms such as circles, ovals, and squares, color tests, etc.

The pilots were kept incommunicade during the tests. There was, however, in each group, an understanding to give as widely divergent answers as possible. We found that in dealing with the Japs, it was better to give a quick though ridiculous answer, which they usually accepted, than to refuse to answer, which invariably brought down severe physical punishment and coercion. To judge by

the remarks some of the interrogators made after the above examination, they were quite frustrated and disappointed. One remarked to the effect that Allied pilots were uneducated imbeciles and physical wrecks. There was apparently no counter-reference system in their intelligence in Java nor any follow-up nor competent analysis.

For recreation, there were a few books and chess sets; many passed the time playing bridge; in the school yard, there were frequent games- soft ball for the Americans, soccer for Dutch and British, and occasionally boxing.

The latter part of October, 1942, orders were received for 100 Americans to leave within 10 hours. This included all able-bodied and some convalescents. We went by train to Batavia where we were placed in a camp for three days awaiting shipment to Singapore. Colonel Searle, F. A. with a few American assistants, were in this camp assisting in the recording and evacuation of POWs. He did much for us, such as obtaining extra food; and his presence enhanced the morale of the American Unit.

About the last of the month, we embarked on a Japanese freighter. We were on the bottom of the holds, with Japanese cavalry enroute to Burma on the mezzanine of one, and officers and sick on the balcony of the other. The conditions were the worst of the entire imprisonment. The heat was suffocating, there was no ventilation, sanitation facilities very inadequate, no bathing, everything and everybody was filthy, and the food was poor. At nights, the Japanese troops would get drunk and throw beer bottles down on the POWs below, or kick them in the face when they tried to come up the ladder. It was so crowded in the holds that the men had to sit up or lie on top of each other. After two days, dysentery broke out and was beginning to reach epidemic proportions by the time we reached Singapore.

We were at Singapore for a month, confined at CHANGI, the former British Army Station. A large group of Americans from the U.S. S. Houston and 131st F.A. We practically had autonomy within the confines of the spacious camp, good bathing facilities, but barely adequate housing and food. A small amount of Red Cross helped a bit. The month's stay did much to restore us after the trip from Batavia.

About the first of December, a group of 90 Americans, 300 English, 900 Dutch and 600 Australians were put aboard the Kamakura Maru for Japan. The men slept on the promenade decks, officers in foyer and corridors. The food was very poor, but the fast ship and plenty of fresh air made it far better than the trip from Batavia. The last two days of the trip brought suffering from cold and rain. On December 7, we anchored in Nagasaki Bay, where 300 were put ashore - all the Americans and about 210 English. We were sent to a small island in the harbor, to work in the dock-yards of Kawaminami Company. The camp was about a mile away, designated as Fukuoka No. 2, and already occupied by 1,000 Americans, English and Dutch.

FIRTHER INFORMATICS REGARDING THIS PARTY.

Just before Isaving Java in September 44, Green, an A.I.F. Civilian at Pulsu Deman Laut, contacted a P.O.W. Petty Officer (Australian ex H.M.A.S.Porth). This P.O. was in charge of clerical assistance at I.J.A. P.O.W. Admin. H.Q., Satavia. P.O. Stated that a notice was posted up in Batavia giving the loss of a ship with 800 Ps.C.W. on board, one hour out of YORCHAMA. There were 2007 casualties including I.J.A. Guards ex Java and British, A.I.P. and Datch Ps.C.W.

Green remembers the name of one P.C.W. (A.I.P.) on the list. "Dos" (Sapper) and personally known to Green. 20
