





These regulations are defined in regard to daily life of those internal in The Chosen War Prisoners Camp.

The prisoners should obey command and order of the comm-Sticle 3

> ander of the Chosen frmy, the superintendent of the Chosen War trisoners' Camp (Including Head officer of Branch Camp and Delached Camp), staff officer and officer of the day. In regard to command and instruction issued by the right of guard commander and now commissioned officer of the day are also the same as above. The prisoners should get on daily life under the imperial Nippon War Disciplines. Those who break the commands or rules mentioned in article 3, or violate the military discipline, or attempt to escape or make resistance and commit dangerous acts are to be subjected to strict punishment accord. ing to the Imperial Military Criminal Law and Punishment Regulations for the same. Be careful not to lose your life by making resistance and dangerous conducts, because soldiers on quand or watch are apt to use arms

if case necessitates. Situle 6 The prisoners are prohibited from assembling and displaying group conduct without permission. stile 7 The prisoners must give the same polite obersand

Article 22 you should not step into the forbidden places, if inyone found going over the stockade or attempting to do so, will be punished or the ground that you hold an intention to escape.

Article 23 Prisoners who refused to take the oath or being placed on the black list will be attached with the attractive marks, and will be porbidden to take a walk in the camp's ground; sometimes, if occasion necessitates, they may be detained.

week) the contact men, including their chief, shall assist in call-roll maintenance of military discipline, sanitation, transmission of command and petitions. They are also responsible for givening best attention to origin of fire:

Article 28

aid officer of the day, in case of officers being included among prisoners, ( to be called an aidofficer, below ) and the now comm scioned aid affect of the day ( to be called aid N. C.O. below )" are to be selected from among the presoners who are to afternte at every noon. " according to instructions of an officer of the day, an aid officer must watch over the check-up of the members, maintenance of military discipline and order, caution against live, neatness and adjustment, sanitary condition and service of the over night watch. aid nor-commissioned officer must look specially over execution of rule regarding fire prevention, working as assistant to the aid officer. He must, under the command of non commissioned officer of the day, accompany patients to the medical officer, be present at consiltation, record the names of

of the patients disease and class of sickness (or accident). Then inform chief contact man to that effect.

Article =9

Two prisoner over night watches (in Jinsen Branch, Jimen Superintendrate discretion) are appointed from each story ( in Jimei, in each lenement) according to the instruction of the prisoner officer of the day. Their service are limited to one hour. They must specially take care of sanitation, prevention of fire and watch over excape. If an escape occur during their service, they will be regarded as conspirator and may be punished decordingly.

Article 30

In each squad, one person each will be appointed in charge of provision, bath-room, commodities and mail, who must take over a portion of the work below mentioned following chief contact man's directions.

(1) Aperson in charge of bath room are responsible for

bathing preparation punctuality of bothing how and givin various aids in the bath room.

(2) A person in charge of provision have responsibility over receipt of and distribution of mede, cleanly

ness; table wares, and conveyance utensils. (3) a person in charge of commodities are responsible for reeping of furniture, applying for repairs, borrowdinated goods.

(4) a person in charge of mail are responsible for management of mails received and dispatched by the prisoners.

Article 31

Persons in charge of after heeping of articles for the use of prisoners are appointed to look after the supplied goods, and to lend, keep and repair articles, clother and other donated goods according to the order of the staff officer.

Book clerks are appointed to lend and manage the donated books. Prison i book clerks is to engage in the management of tinding of books, magazines and newspapers according to the order of staff officer. Siticle 32

Chief contact man of each ragued is appointed to assist in business of prico, ers mails. He is to engage in business of collection and activery of prisoners mails according to creater of the staff officer. Article 33

34 Cooks are selected to prepare meals for the prisoners. They must act according to the order and supervision of the staff officer, and their works are as follows; Article

(1) Receiving materials for the preparation of meals from the staff officer and his refresentatives.

(2) Cleanness and adjustment of cookery.

(1) Equal distribution of foods.

Prisoners' canteen clerk is appointed for manage Article 35. ment of their canteen, consisting of one N.C.O. (Ir warrant officer and three sailars or soldiers, who will work under staff's direction, and act according to the prisoners canteen rules.

Chapter 4. Prevention of Fire

Prisoners must always be cautious against fire, for it may aften accur owing to carelessness or negligence. Srticle 36

Extinguish the fire after its use. An aid non-commi-simed officer must inspect if the fire was surely Article 37

extinguished or not.

Smoking and other conducts liable to bring about fine are prohibited in store room of fuel; and don't place articles which easily catch fire in the barraks. Strule 38

and non-commissioned officer must inspect if fire in brazier is surely extinguished or not, and a: I trays are gathered at the designated place, or not, prior to the evening roll-call, and then? receive the inspection of commander of quards. Unburnt charcoals in brazier are filtered out by ash feller and then carry it to the guard house. As to the handling of store, we will inform you eater.

Number of braziers and ash pots will be elucidated a respective places by tags. Article 110

Cinders of rookery are to be rejected and thrown in damping places. Same applies to the bath houses Article 41

Tobacco ash must be cast into the ash trays or braziers. Article 42

Article 43 Use of candles and matches is prohibited without permission.

Isticle 44 'It immergency trumpet sound prisoners must line up at a definite place in the barrak in order to be inspected by the officer of the day.

Chapter 5 Hygiene.

Article 45 Prisoners are requested to pay special attention to their health and prevention of accidents, and prevention of accidents, and prevention of epidemics and contagious disease. Clothing must be kept clean and exposed to the sun light.

I am Colonel J. Maquehi, Superintendent of the Chosen War prisoners Camp. Receiving you here, I should like to give necessary instruction to

I hope you will consider how this greater East Asia War happened. Neppons derired for peaceful settlement arising from the conciliatory spirit, rejected by america and British in order to attain Their ambitious demand to Best Usia. Finally they overwh lined nippon, the important defenser of asia, to the extent that they dared to resort to violence of economic disruption.

Promoting Chimese internal confusion and increasing military preparation on all sides of rippon Empire to challenge us, thus the very expistence of our nation being in danger, we stood up resolutely with unity of will, strong so iron, under the name of Jenno (Emperor) for the eman cipation of the nations and eli mination of enil sources in East asia.

The rise or fall of our Empire that has the glarious history and the progress or decline depend upon The present War. Firm and unshakable is ver national resolve, that we should outsh our concore the U.S. A.

and the Britain.

It eaven is always on the side of Justice. Within ten days after the War Declaration, our navy and naval Air Forces anni hilated both the american pacific fleet and the British Far Eastern Fleet; within a few mon tho, · american and British long established army, navy, and air Bases were crushed by our army and army air Forces; and now, tide turning in our favour, all parts of regions lin ked with Burma, Java, and Wake Island have already been occupied by us, and the in habitants there are rejoicing in cooperation with us for the construction Hew Usia. and now these above facts have induced the Indian rebellion and Australia come to a cricio of capture. Afterward our belligerents sent their air crafts and flects for the rescue, but every Time They were sunk to The bottom or destroyed and repulsed, Thus the total damages come up to 2801 vessels and 4500 Hircrafts.

I Think These war results do not signify the inferior power of our enemy, but rather owe to own absolute indo-mitable power. That is to say the power protected by Kami (deaven). Wherever Nippon army and Mary advance, Jenyu Shinjo (Special providencial (delp) always follows; you should rocognize the fact and consider the reasons.

Nippor. army and Mary are under the Imperial Command of Jenno (Enyeror) who is the personi fication of Kami (fed), so that the Imperial troops are to be called the Troops of fod. Now you have become

war prisoners because of struggling against Kamino-fun (fod's army), and now you are convinced of fearful ness to the marrow and became aware of unsavoury resulto. What do you think of this?

- However you have lost gighting strength now, you once fought firely against us. Judging from this fact some og you will hold hostile feeling against us in your hearts that can never be permission. accordingly, we will punish you if you act against our regulations, for instance the non-fulfilment of regulations, disabedience, resistance and excape ( even an attempt to do so) are understood as manifestation of hostility. I kindly requested you that you must be cautious

not spiriling your selves by punish ment.

But on the other hand, with hippon warriors forgineness I express respect to your futhfulness to your country and fulfilment of your duty, and feel pitiful for your capitulation after exhaustion.

you should reflect on your selves. according to the extent of your malice feeling we also put certain limit to your freedom you enjoy or severity and lemity on your treatment.

Parolo is of use as a proof of wip ing away your hostility. I am regret ful to say those requised to swear will be treated as per sons, of wenemy character, will be placed under restraint regarding main tenance of honour, protection of your persons, and must

endure pain in compensation of hostility. The details of conctrete out line of style of daily life are defined in "The regulation regarding to daily life"; you should put them into practice strictly after reading over them.

prejudice against labour and grumbling over food, clothing and having are strictly probibited, because the change in your daily life and wistom are in evitable under present war si Tuation.

closing my instruction, I advise you all to find interest and anxiety in your forthcoming daily life by acting according the Imperial military discipline.
