REMARKS

THE UNFEDERATED MALAY STATES

AND THE FEDERATED MALAY STATES

Agreement made the day of 19.....
Between the Inspector of Prisons, Straits Settlements and Federated Malay States,

and attention to the service of the Government and shall use his utmost efforts to promote the interest of the Government. He shall conform to the General Orders of the local Government and to the Regulations for His Majesty's Service in so far as the same are applicable. He will be required to acquire sufficient knowledge of Malay for the performance of his duties.

(1) Increment of salary will be reckoned as from the date of engagement under agreement, but no increment will be granted unless the conduct and diligence of person engaged during the year immediately preceding have been approved. The rate of such approval shall be a certificate signed by the Head of his Department assigned by an officer authorised by the Government in that behalf.

2) The salary of the person engaged may be liable to deductions under Clauses 9 or 10. The person engaged shall also be paid such field and other allowances as he is entitled to under the General Orders issued from time to time by the Government which he is serving.

—(3) "Passage" in this Agreement means a passage of a class and on a steamer vessel by the Government.

3) The Government shall provide the person engaged with a passage from the Kingdom for his wife and children (if any) not exceeding four persons, provided they proceed to join him within twelve months after the date of his engagement under this Agreement, and upon the satisfactory termination of his Agreement and in accordance with Clause 8, with a free passage to England for himself and if married, for his wife and children (if any) not exceeding four persons besides himself, provided that the person engaged avails himself of such passages within one month from the date of such termination.

JAVA PARTY No.21.

1. This Party left Java on 22.6.44 and arrived at F. Barce on 22.6.44 and according to the IJA Rolls this party contained 1 625 or 1 627 R.N.F.
